TECHNICALLY SPEAKING

Should You License Your Dish?

There's been quite a stir about the FCC's potential reallocation of the C-band spectrum (3.7GHz to 4.2GHz) for expanded and improved mobile broadband. No smartphone user wouldn't love better data rates and high caps. But this smartphone user wouldn't. The proposed change threatens every traditional satellite operator and their customers including Amb-OS and most of the Christian Radio Consortium members (Amb-OS, Salem, Moody, Northwestern, VCY, etc.).

Radio station operators who installed a receive-only (RO) satellite antenna typically did not go to the effort of registering or licensing their site. It wasn't necessary. A satellite dish points to the sky while, terrestrial microwave signals traveled along the surface of the earth so there were few instances of Terrestrial Microwave Interference (TMI). Through the decades, common C-band terrestrial microwave carriers moved off the technology in favor of much more efficient and robust media like fiber.

So, in the absence of a real sense for how much C-band is used, the FCC started eyeing this chunk of spectrum for the ever-hungry cellular industry. Then, on April 19, 2018, the FCC issued a Notice of Inquiry (NOI) which established a 90-day window which allowed entities to register or license their antennas, providing a clear picture on the use of the spectrum. We think you should register your dish, just like we did!

This is not a requirement (as was the thinking of one station with whom I spoke). It's optional. But it will help protect and preserve this spectrum for broadcast purposes.
