

JOHN MACARTHUR | GRACE TO YOU

A very special moment of this year's Convention was the induction of Bible teacher John MacArthur into the NRB "Hall of Fame." We asked John to share some personal reflections in view of this milestone:

"What else is there

The first teacher that influenced my life was my dad, Dr. Jack MacArthur. He was my pastor for all of the years of my life until I was in the ministry myself. He was the one who most influenced me—and in many ways. His total love for and trust in scripture had a huge impact on me. His diligence as a student—he read and read and read. I never had two conversations with him that were the same because he was always fresh, and was reading all of the time. His sense of diligence about interpreting scripture and preaching scripture had a huge impact on my life.

What constrained me to "verse by verse" teaching is that it's the only way to explain the scripture. That's the calling every minister has and what we're called to do—to pass on the Word of God and to tell people what it means by what it says—it's very simple. That's the top and bottom and side to side of ministry. What else is there but to explain the for people meaning of the revelation of God?

What has been most encouraging about the Grace to You outreach is what an appetite there is globally for teaching the Word of God. If you listen to the modern architects of ministry, you would think people don't want to hear scripture. They want to be

entertained; they want to be concertized to one degree or another. They want an emotional experience and they want some kind of a "high." Nothing really is being advocated today along the line of "let's get more serious, let's get deeper into the Word of God" and yet the hunger for that is amazing. It's staggering when you think that somewhere between 2 and 3 million sermons are downloaded from the Grace to You website every month. We're finding out there's an appetite for the Word of God and that's exciting!

I don't know that there's a particular book in the Bible that's my favorite, but I think it would be the four Gospels because Jesus is my favorite person! That's why I'm so thrilled about "One Perfect Life". It takes the four Gospels and blends them into one perfectly

harmonized narrative. I'm just so thrilled to be able to provide that for people so they can read the story of Jesus in one story with all four Gospels blended together.


