
#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

#### New to Amb-OS


#### **TECH TALK**

#### "I Just Called to Say Your Eb/No is Low."

Here's some granular tech talk. (If you've never heard the term "EbNo" before, skip to the photo section in Update.)

Eb/No is one measurement of a good satellite signal. Simplistically said, it's a ratio between the energy per digital bit of a signal and the carrier noise. The higher the number, the better.

There are lots of reasons satellite dishes have low or no Eb/No ratios. In summertime, it's often a beehive or wasps nest in the antenna feed horn. In winter, it's most often snow. But in either case, you need to remedy the situation.



Here's the good news: If your Amb-OS receiver is connected to the Internet, it will continue to receive files even if your Eb/No is zero and you have no satellite signal. However, you still want to know so you can take action.

And here's how: Open the Amb-OS User Interface (UI) and click on the TOOLS menu. Then click on MANAGE STATUS INDICATORS and you'll see a screen similar to the one below. Set your Eb/No thresholds, email addresses and which warnings, click on SAVE, and you're good to go!






