





I've been wondering if there had ever been a documentary or movie made about the baseball player-turnedevangelist, Billy Sunday.

So my thought was, "If not, then why not?" His life story is pretty interesting: He was mildly successful as a major league ball player from 1883 until 1890, where he played nearly 500 games. He had become a Christian while playing baseball. A few years after his career ended, he began preaching, which he did so quite effectively for the next 40 years. By most accounts, he was well-respected. The biopic would appeal to film goers who love period films and baseball (he lived from 1862 to 1935).

A quick look at Google images suggests that the evangelist liked to pose for "action" pictures that evoked his playing days. So I am guessing that a film could easily portray Sunday's flair for the dramatic, and, I hope it would reflect his unabashed approach on the subject of sin, repentance, and salvation.
