**DID YOU KNOW?**

- **Chicago O'Hare Airport** is named after Edward "Butch" O'Hare. O'Hare was a naval aviator who won the Medal of Honor for holding off a formation of heavy bombers that were attacking his aircraft carrier on February 20, 1942. O'Hare was killed later in WWII when he led the first ever nighttime fighter attack against a group of Japanese torpedo bombers in 1943. Chicago's Orchard Depot Airport became O'Hare International Airport in his honor in 1949.
- The aptly-named "Pine Tree State" is perhaps best known for its beautiful lighthouses and lobster industry. **Maine** is also the only state that shares its border with only one other U.S state— **New Hampshire**. Take a look at a map for geography refresher!
