DID YOU KNOW? FOOD ALLERGY EDITION

- One in ten U.S. adults have a food allergy. More than **25 percent** of those adults said they weren't allergic to foods as a child.
- One in 13 U.S. kids under the age of 18 have a food allergy. That's 8 percent of all children in the country.
- The **rate of food allergies** among kids has **doubled** in the last two decades.
- An estimated **32 million Americans** are living with food allergies— and about 5.6 **million** are under the age of 18.
- Airlines are required to allow passengers with severe food allergies to pre-board so they can wipe down surfaces around their seats.
