**DID YOU KNOW?**

- Known as “**the Met**,” New York City's **Metropolitan Museum of Art** is the *largest museum in the USA*, spanning about 2 million square feet.
- Its permanent collection of more than **two million pieces of art** includes works by Picasso, Monet, Renoir, Rembrandt, and Van Gogh.
- **Founded in 1870**, the main building is located along Central Park on Manhattan’s Upper East Side. In 2019, nearly **6.5 million people visited**, making it the fourth-most visited museum in the world.
- If you visited the Met before 2013, you likely received a **metal button emblazoned** with the museum’s logo, this has since been retired due to the increased metal prices in recent years.
