- Known as "the Met," New York City's Metropolitan Museum of Art is the largest museum in the USA, spanning about 2 million square feet.
- Its permanent collection of more than two million pieces of art includes works by Picasso, Monet, Renoir, Rembrandt, and Van Gogh.
- Founded in 1870, the main building is located along Central Park on Manhattan's Upper East Side. In 2019, nearly **6.5 million people visited**, making it the fourth-most visited museum in the world.
- If you visited the Met before 2013, you likely received a **metal button** emblazoned with the museum's logo, this has since been retired due to the increased metal prices in recent years.
