DID YOU KNOW?

For about 70 years, the small Hawaiian island of Lanai was home to one of the world's largest **pineapple plantations**, earning the nickname "Pineapple Island." In 1922, James Drummond Dole purchased most of the island for \$1.1 million to cultivate fields that would yield Dole Food Company's pineapples. By 1930, the island was exporting 65,000 tons of pineapples a year, and at its peak produced 75% of the world's supply of the tropical fruit. But Lanai stopped growing pineapples in 1992 after overseas competition made it less profitable.

Today, Costa Rica is the world's top producer of pineapples.
