- Next on the list are **India** (560 million users), the **United States** (293 million), **Indonesia** (171 million), and **Brazil** (149 million).
- The comparatively tiny nation of **Iceland** boasts the highest percentage of internet users in its population, with 98.25% having access to the web. On the opposite end of the spectrum is the **African** country of Eritrea, with only 1.31% of its population connected to the Internet.
