- The **Etch-A-Sketch** is from French inventor André Cassagnes. The Spin Master Company owns the toy but the Ohio Art Company does the manufacturing, giving this toy an international feel being invented in France, owned in Canada, and manufactured in America.
- In February 2020, the world's largest aerial firework went off. Weighing in at 2797 pounds, it detonated over Steamboat Springs, Colorado. It was ejected by a tube at 300 miles per hour and set a **Guinness** World Record in the process.
- July 17th will mark **Disneyland's 66th birthday.** The original opening day is referred to as "Black Sunday" by some because of a few horrible oversights and unfinished attractions.
- **Skunks** are typically born in May and June in litters of 4-6. By the end of August, they are usually ready to leave their mother.
