#### DID YOU KNOW?

- The oldest carousel in America is the Flying Horses Carousel in Oak Bluffs, Massachusetts. It was constructed in 1876 by Charles Dare and was originally operated as an attraction on Coney Island, but it was moved to Oak Bluffs, in 1884.
- There are 13,447 McDonald's **locations** in the United States as of September 12, 2021. The state with the most number of McDonald's locations in the US is California, with 1,221 locations, which is 9% of all McDonald's locations in America.
- Just like spoken languages, sign language changes depending on the country you're in. Even though Britain and the USA both speak in English, their sign languages are very different! Differences can also be found in regional sign language - similar to how accents and dialects are reflected in speech.
- When Rolling Stone magazine compiled its "500 Greatest Songs of All Time," it placed "Jailhouse Rock" at #67, and on the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame's "500 Songs That Shaped Rock and Roll," it's listed at #204.
