MONDAY 10/11

We celebrate *Christopher Columbus' discovery of the Americas*. He was hoping to sail to India but his slight error turned into the discovery of the New World!

In 1931, the *Christ the Redeemer* statue opened on top of Mount Corcovado overlooking Rio de Janeiro. The statue stands 98ft high and 92ft wide measured at the outstretched arms.

DID YOU KNOW?

- **Mount Everest** reaches the highest altitude of any mountain on Earth, at 29,029 feet above sea level, but it is not actually the world's tallest when measured from base to peak. From its base, which is submerged deep in the Pacific Ocean, **Mauna Kea** measures 33,497 feet in total (although its summit is only 13,803 feet above sea level). The extinct volcano last erupted about 4,600 years ago.
- "**Stewardesses**" is the longest word typed with only the left hand and "**lollipop**" with your right.
- "**Typewriter**" is the longest word that can be made using the letters only on one row of the keyboard.
 - The original **Poohsticks Bridge**, featured in A.A. Milne's *Winnie the Pooh* books, has gone up for auction. The bridge is located in the Ashdown Forest in England and it's estimated to sell for around \$54,000 to \$81,000.
