MONDAY 10/18

On this day, 67 years ago, Texas Instruments announced plans for the *Regency TR-1*, the first transistor radio to be commercially sold. Even at \$49.95, nearly 100,000 radios were sold in a year!

TUESDAY 10/19

National Kentucky Day recognizes the 15th state to be granted statehood. Home to the Kentucky Derby, fried chicken, Fort Knox and the birthplace of Abraham Lincoln.

WEDNESDAY 10/20

Monterey Bay Aquarium, one of the largest aquariums in the world opened in California on this day in 1984. It is home to more than 77,000 animals representing 774 species.

THURSDAY 10/21

"Roads? Where we're going, we don't need roads!" *Back to the Future Day* is celebrated on October 21, because that is the date Marty McFly travels to the past in the original film.

FRIDAY 10/22

Another 'nutty' holiday today. . . *National Nut Day* is dedicated to the snack that is overflowing with health benefits. No matter what you eat today; include a healthy helping of nuts!

DID YOU KNOW?

- **Post-its** were invented in Kentucky by Dr. Spencer Silver, a scientist at 3M. The iconic office supplies are still solely manufactured at 3M's plant in Cynthiana, Ky.
- In 2005, a campaign to recognize the **orange** as Florida's official state fruit was organized and quickly succeeded. More than **90%** of America's orange juice is made with Florida-grown oranges.
- The longest a great white shark has been kept in captivity is **198 days**, at the Monterey Bay Aquarium. The tank was specially designed for open ocean animals, holding 3.78 million liters of water with a depth of 10.6 meters.
- The **Chicago Cubs** became World Series champions for the first time in 108 years in 2016. What's more amazing about the Cubs' win, is they did it only a year after it was predicted to happen in 1989's '**Back to the Future II**.'
