DID YOU KNOW?

- The three most **popular shapes of pasta** are spaghetti, macaroni, and penne.
- Over **1.5 billion pounds** of pumpkin are produced each year in the United States. The top pumpkin-producing states are Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, Pennsylvania, and California.
- The mayor of New York City, George B. McClellan, officially opened the **New York City subway system**. The first subway train left City Hall station with the mayor at the controls, and 26 minutes later arrived at 145th Street.
- **Pule** is one of the world's rarest cheeses--and the most expensive! Made from the milk of Balkan donkeys (native only to Serbia and Montenegro), pule costs around \$600 per pound. Why so pricey? It requires **25 liters of donkey's milk** to produce just one kilogram of cheese.
