Did You Know?

- In Sweden, daily coffee breaks are called "fika" which to do properly, you must leave your work at your desk, meet up with friends, and snack and chat over coffee (or another hot drink supplied free by the employer). At many companies, the breaks are mandatory.
- Visitors can see **Dorothy's House** from the Wizard of OZ in Liberal, Kansas. Dorothy's House was built in 1907. It was donated to the Seward County Historical Society and was moved to the present location. Since then it has been carefully restored and furnished to replicate the house as is seen in the beloved 1939 movie.
- Sun Valley, Idaho is where the world's first chairlift was introduced in 1936. Designed by James Curran of the Union Pacific Railroad, the innovative chairs were installed on Dollar and Proctor mountains and helped put Sun Valley on the map as a destination ski resort.
