MONDAY 1/24

National Peanut Butter Day is to recognize the staple that is in every pantry! Marcellus Gilmore Edson first patented peanut butter in 1884 and probably didn't know the impact it would later make.

TUESDAY 1/25

In 1905, in Pretoria, South Africa, a *3,106-carat diamond* is discovered during a routine inspection. Weighing 1.33 pounds, and christened the "Cullinan," it was the largest diamond ever found.

WEDNESDAY 1/26

Happy 185th Birthday, Michigan! On this day in 1837, "The Great Lakes State" was granted statehood after the conclusion of the Toledo War and became the 26th state.

THURSDAY 1/27

International Holocaust Remembrance Day is a day that commemorates the victims of the Holocaust. This day was chosen to recognize the date that Auschwitz concentration camp was liberated.

FRIDAY 1/28

On January 28, 1958, LEGO submitted a patent application for the plastic bricks we know and love today with interlocking studs and tubes. To mark the date, we celebrate *National LEGO Day!*

DID YOU KNOW?

- **There are six cities in the U.S. named Peanut:** Peanut, California; Lower Peanut, Pennsylvania; Upper Peanut, Pennsylvania; Peanut, Pennsylvania, Peanut, Tennessee; and Peanut West Virginia.
 - Shortly after the Revolutionary War in 1784, several counties in what is now northeastern Tennessee (at the time, they were part of North Carolina) declared themselves the **independent state of Franklin**. The name choice wasn't coincidental – the residents were trying to sway Benjamin Franklin (and his followers) to recognize the state, but the vote for statehood failed in Congress.
 - Michigan's state motto is: **"If you seek a pleasant peninsula, look about you."**
 - The UK's James May built a LEGO house out of **3.3 million bricks**. It contained a working toilet, shower, and bed. The house was torn down shortly after.
