DID YOU KNOW?

- Founded in 1961, the **Johnson Space Center in Houston** has been the site of mission control for some of the world's most historic space expeditions. Recognize the famous line "Houston, we have a problem"--the quote came from astronaut John Swigert on the beleaguered Apollo 13 mission, who was radioing NASA mission control in Houston.
- There are **2,059 bird species** in the continent of North America, according to data from the Cornell Lab of Ornithology
- Airlines began serving food onboard as early as 1919, when British airline Handley Page sold pre-packaged lunches for three shillings (around \$10 today). Technical innovation eventually allowed United Airlines to install kitchens aboard their planes, giving passengers access to hot meals in the sky. The airline's early airborne diners got to choose between fried chicken and scrambled eggs.
