THURSDAY 2/17

While the Suez Canal didn't officially open until November 1869, today marks 155 years since the S.S. Dido became the first ship to pass through the canal from the Red Sea to the Mediterranean Sea.

FRIDAY 2/18

Clyde Tombaugh, a newly hired assistant at Lowell Observatory, discovered Pluto on this day in 1930! Pluto's planethood has since been revoked, but he remains the favorite "planet" of many!

DID YOU KNOW?

- The first heart-shaped box of chocolates was introduced in 1861. It was created by Richard Cadbury, son of Cadbury founder John Cadbury, who started packaging chocolates in fancy boxes to increase sales.
- After years of remarkable work as an attorney, Thurgood Marshall became the first African American to serve in the U.S. Supreme Court. Officially nominated by President Lyndon B. Johnson in 1967, he served as a justice until 1991.
- Before 1940, the U.S. military had barred Black people from flying planes, but after lobbying from civil rights organizations and the press, the first squadron of Black pilots was formed in Tuskegee, Alabama. Between 1941 and 1946, more than **1,000 Black pilots** trained at Moton Field. The Tuskegee Airmen National Historic Site preserves Moton Field and its Hangar One, including one of the red-striped planes flown by the Tuskegee Airmen.
