DID YOU KNOW?

- “**Strengths**” is the longest word in the English language with one vowel.
- Dogs only have 1/6 the number of taste buds humans do, but a dog's sense of smell is between 10,000 to **1,000,000 times better than humans.**
- In 1936, a socialite brought the first giant panda cub from China to the United States. Named **Su Lin**, the cub lived at Chicago's Brookfield Zoo. China banned foreign panda hunters in the 1940s, but after President Richard Nixon visited China in 1972, the country gifted two panda bears to the Smithsonian National Zoo. Since the 1980s, China has only loaned its pandas to other zoos, retaining ownership of every panda worldwide.
- The record of 116 wins in a 162-game season has only been achieved by two teams in the history of major league baseball, facts and stats show. These teams were the **Seattle Mariners** in 2001 and the **Chicago Cubs** in 1906.
