National Superhero Day is a huge day for superhero geeks, movie lovers, artists, comic book collectors, and pop-culture enthusiasts. The day was founded in 1995 by none other than Marvel Comics.

FRIDAY 4/29

DID YOU KNOW?

- Truman rolled the first ball on the new White House alley, knocking down 7 out of 10 pins. One of the pins is now on display at the Smithsonian Institution.
- **The Loop** is the primary business district of Chicago and is home to some of the city's tallest and most famous buildings. The dominant structure of the neighborhood is the **Willis Tower** (formerly the Sears Tower), which is on the Loop's western end near the Chicago River. At 1,450 feet tall, Willis Tower was the tallest building in the world from its completion in 1973 until 1998.
- Photographer Nat Fein took the rear-view photo of an ailing Babe Ruth at Yankee Stadium during a farewell to the Sultan of Swat on June 13, 1948. The photo, "Babe Bows Out," would become one of the most famous images of the 20th century.
- Spiderman's first appearance is in the 15th edition of "Amazing Fantasy."
