DID YOU KNOW?

- In 2011 Belgian scientists used lasers to measure Usain Bolt's performance in the different stages of a 100-meter race held in September that year. They found that, 67.13 meters into the race, **Bolt** reached a top speed of 27.33 miles per hour.
- **Bonaire** is a long way from the Netherlands, but the tiny Caribbean island is nonetheless a special municipality of the Dutch Kingdom. It forms part of the "ABC Islands," the westernmost island group in the Leeward Antilles. "A" stands for Aruba, and "C" stands for Curação. Located about 50 miles north of Venezuela, Bonaire is only about 110 square miles.
- St. Paul, Minnesota, was originally called Pig's Eye after a man named Pierre 'Pig's Eye' Parrant who set up the first business there.
