- In 2019, pitcher Edwin Jackson became the first player in history to play for 14 MLB teams, a feat accomplished within the first 17 years of his still-active career. The previous record was held by Octavio Dotel, also a pitcher. Dotel played for 13 teams during his 15year MLB career.
- Although there were no only-children, three presidents only had one sibling: Calvin Coolidge, Franklin D. Roosevelt, and Ronald Reagan.
