MONDAY 10/17

Mother Teresa was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize for her humanitarian work with the poor. By the time she passed away in 1979, her Missionaries of Charity foundation had grown to 610 foundations in 123 countries.

TUESDAY 10/18

Charles Strite was granted a US patent for his invention, the automatic pop-up toaster, which he named the Toastmaster. This eliminated the need to manually remove the toast from the toaster – saving toast, and fingers, from burning.

Today in 1985, *the first Blockbuster video-rental store opened*, in Dallas, Texas. Opening with some 8,000 tapes displayed on shelves around the store Blockbuster also utilized a computerized check-out process

THURSDAY 10/20

Designed by Danish architect Jørn Utzon, Australia's Sydney Opera House, was opened by Queen Elizabeth II on this day in 1973.

DID YOU KNOW?

• Rather than having the traditional Nobel honor banquet, **Mother Teresa had the money for the 1979 banquet be sent to her mission in Calcutta**, where it would feed 400 people for a full year.

• The toasting process is known as the **Maillard reaction**. When bread is subjected to 280-330 degrees Fahrenheit, the sugars begin to brown and form the crunchy surface toast is delightedly known for.

• When the Sydney Symphony Orchestra is on stage in the Concert Hall, **the temperature must be 22.5 degrees Celsius to ensure the instruments stay in tune**.

• It takes about **36 apples** to create one gallon of apple cider.
