MONDAY 11/14

Today in 1851, *Herman Melville published his sixth book, Moby-Dick.* Although initially considered a flop, *Moby-Dick* is now considered to be one of the great American literary classics.

TUESDAY 11/15

The bundt cake pan design is derived from a type of European cake called the Gugelhupf. Today, *National Bundt Day* celebrates this cake's popularity, which began in 1966 when Ella Helfrich won the Pillsbury Bake-Off with her "Tunnel of Fudge" bundt cake.

WEDNESDAY 11/16

During the end of his great journey in 1855, David Livingstone arrived at thundering falls on the Zambezi river and named them the Victoria Falls after his queen. Victoria Falls is twice as wide and twice as deep as Niagara Falls, spanning 5,500 ft across.

THURSDAY 11/17

Doug Englebart the "Father of the Mouse," *received his patent for the first computer mouse* today, in 1970. It occurred to him that by using a pair of small wheels traversing a tabletop, the computer could track their rotations and move the cursor on the display.

FRIDAY 11/18

At exactly noon today in 1883, *American and Canadian railroads begin using four continental time zones* to end the confusion of dealing with thousands of local times. However, it was not until 1918 that Congress officially adopted the railroad time zones.

DID YOU KNOW?

• After Herman Melville's death in 1891, *Moby-Dick was reprinted* and, this time around, critics started to take it more seriously. There was a flurry of interest in Melville's work in 1919, the centennial of his birth.

• A one-way trip on the **Trans-Siberian Railway** involves crossing 3,901 bridges.

• The prototype computer mouse that Doug Englebart made was out of wood. The design was simple: a box with two wheels at the bottom and only one key.

• Today, the **U.S. Department of Transportation** oversees the nation's time zones and the uniform observance of **Daylight Saving Time**, including exercising the authority that allows a state to change its official time zone.
