- *The Sound of Music* was so successful, it surpassed *Gone With The Wind* as the number one box office to date.

- The version of “The Star-Spangled Banner” traditionally sung on patriotic occasions and at sporting events is only the song’s first verse. All four verses conclude with the same line: “O’er the land of the free and the home of the brave.”
