TUESDAY 3/21

“Amazing grace, how sweet the sound.” On this day in 1747 **John Newton realized his need for a Savior after a near death experience on a storm tossed ship.** Twenty-five years later he wrote one of the most famous hymns, a reflection of his turbulent life.

WEDNESDAY 3/22

Today in 1894, **the first championship games for the Stanley Cup were played.** The championship was created by Sir Frederick Arthur Stanley, who was an avid hockey fan. Since 1962 the same trophy has been used with each winning team holding on to it for a year.

THURSDAY 3/23

The *Boston Morning Post* first published the initials “O.K.” in 1839 thus introducing it into the mainstream American vernacular. O.K. is an abbreviation of the slang “oll korrekt,” misspelling using an O and a K.

FRIDAY 3/23

A Vaudeville performer and actress named **Belle Baker** hosted a program in a moving train, the very first to do so, for a variety radio show. This show was broadcast on WABC in New York City, originating from a Baltimore and Ohio train that traveled around the New York region.

DID YOU KNOW?

- The first day of spring is called the vernal equinox. The term vernal is Latin for “spring” and equinox is Latin for “equal night.”
- It’s estimated that **Amazing Grace** has been performed over 10 million times and has impressively appeared on over 11,000 albums worldwide.
- The **Stanley Cup** is the only trophy in major sports that is not reproduced each year.
- The **Boston Post** folded in **1956** due to increasing competition from Hearst-run papers and from radio and television news.
- **Vaudeville** was a type of entertainment popular chiefly in the US in the early 20th century, featuring a mixture of specialty acts such as burlesque comedy and song and dance.
