An Ephesians 3:20 Moment

"Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen." Ephesians 3:20-21 (NASB)

When I read Paul's moving benediction to the church at Ephesus, I always think about Amb-OS. That's because the depth and breadth of work Amb-OS provides via satellite has grown beyond anything any of us initially could ask or think! Candidly, I had no idea where it would take us when this all started.



I walk into our Technical Operations Center and I stand amazed! We are at that Ephesians 3:20 moment. Consequently, we know God has had His hand on this project. God has brought us here.

Amb-OS started as a simple idea to meet a simple problem: How to

get teaching/talk programs to stations in a timely fashion. The technology would require hands-free operation, consistency, dependability, quality and immediacy.

When we started, for those who would care, we had a room filled with 14 Otari ARS-1000 reel-to-reel automation machines, cart decks and three-line hybrids. A pair of 8088 processor computers were used to close a series of relays. They were fraught will problems and stations would regularly have to call for re-feeds when a program recording was missed.

Then the idea of a "store forward" system appeared on the horizon. And more than a few hurdles needed to be clear. For example, we spent a year pursuing licenses for six patents on the technology. Then there was the fact that no one built such a satellite/internet receiver, so we found a wonderful manufacturing companion to help us build the radio. The good news is



that through the years, the "if you build it they will come" philosophy has proven true! We serve over 125 different broadcast partners, both live and pre-recorded.

Yes, God has been faithful. At each step along the way, He closed doors and opened others. The result has been absolutely "abundantly beyond all that I could ask or think!" And I conclude as the passage does, "To Him be [all] the glory."

God's Great Outdoors has been a wonderful broadcast ministry to those especially interested in outdoor sporting. Last November, the Lord called its host and president, Gerry Caillouet, home to be with Him. Gerry's vision was to use outdoor activities as a vehicle to share the Gospel and build into the lives of those who need a deeper relationship with their Creator.

MINISTRY UPDATE

The Global Mercy Sails into Action!

"One Port - Two Nations" Senegal and the Gambia 2023

Designed to deliver hope and healing to nations with limited surgical capacity, the *Global Mercy* is now ready to fulfill her purpose. This year marks the first in an expected 50-year lifespan of specialized free surgeries and medical training taking place on board.

In February, the purpose-built hospital ship arrived in the Port of Dakar (Senegal) to much rejoicing as it's expected that over the next five months, more than 800 maxillofacial, pediatric orthopedic, pediatric general, general and eye surgeries will be carried out on board. About 25% of the patients will likely come from the Gambia as the ship serves two countries while in the one port.

The ship has the capacity to accommodate up to 950 people including a community of volunteers from around the world, serving for anywhere from a few weeks to years at a time. Each crew member comes to Mercy Ships to work voluntarily in their area of expertise, from the hospital wards to the galley, engine room, or beyond.

More than 1,500 volunteers from over 60 nations serve with Mercy Ships each year. From surgeons and medical staff to the captain, cooks, AV technicians, teachers, electricians, biomedical technicians, and more, our crew has an array of skills and specialties needed to make a difference in the countries we serve!



Why Ships?

Because 50% of the world's population lives near a coast, our floating hospitals are the best way to reach and treat people in need.



Why Africa?

Because there are only two physicians per 10,000 people in sub-Saharan Africa, many people suffer and die from treatable conditions.



Why You?

It takes a wide range of people & skills to run a hospital ship, and our allvolunteer crew makes it happen. You can help make a difference.

Like my old radio DJ days, I have "current," "recurrent," and "gold" categories for my books.


Within those categories on my shelves I tend to group books by topic and/or by author. Some bookshelves are for recurring use, like Bible study resources. Other shelves are for inspiration.
