UPDATE FROM DICK BECVAR



Several folks have inquired about the progress of on-boarding our next-generation satellite/Internet receiver, the AMR-200 – We're happy to report that the Alpha testing portion of this new hardware platform has been completed and, with the gracious help from six station beta testers, we've begun the final phase of our pre-release tests.

The new receiver builds upon the design of our current AMR-100 architecture and fully meshes with our existing command/

control/transmission infrastructure. We're deeply indebted to the Lord for connecting us with Canada-based International Datacasting Corporation to manufacture the 200 hardware platform under a unique agreement that enables us to develop our own unique operating software.

Some years ago when we embarked upon the journey to find a capable vendor who would be compatible with our existing system (instead of purchasing a complete new system) we found that the notion of providing a stand-alone hardware component was a non-starter for virtually all potential parties except IDC. They've proved to be a superb partner working with our talented in-house software developers, Dr. Boyd Gafford and Dave Allen!

The Lord also has allowed us to bring online a third high-bandwidth transmission site just down the street from our TOC in Irvine, CA. The additional site will power a new transmission mode, debuting first with the AMR-200 but later added to existing AMR-100 capabilities.

For well-Internet-provisioned station sites this new transmission mode will afford virtually the same real-time transmission capacity as our satellite carrier but will utilize a low-latency Internet connection. For many years we've had the ability to send pre-recorded and live programs to AMR-100s via Internet, but the additional mode and facilities will maximize our end-to-end capability and functionality.

We'll provide more information about these and other enhancements as the days go forward – Stay tuned!





A New Project for John MacArthur



And ... a New Leg for Amadou

As the Global Mercy has begun its first surgical field service, four-year-old Amadou is the first patient to receive surgery on the ship—actually two surgeries to correct malformed legs.

It's expected that more than 800 surgeries will be performed by Mercy Ships volunteer physicians over the next several months as the ship dually serves the countries of Senegal and The Gambia. While docked in Dakar, staff will also be in the field to serve in other areas of medical concern including training for in-country professionals.
