## EXPANDING IMPACT

### On Eagles' Wings Leadership Center

It was a joy for our Charley Mefferd to head slightly east to Arkansas for a firsthand look at an extraordinary project nearing completion.

For decades, **Ron Hutchcraft** has been burdened by the desire to reach the "first Americans"—the Native people of North America. Despite efforts by many, tragically, today only an estimated 4% of that population have a relationship with Christ.







With a commitment to equip *Native* "messengers of hope," the Ron Hutchcraft Ministries (RHM) organization is putting the final touches on a new 22,000-square-foot On Eagles' Wings Leadership Center where that work can be done in earnest.

Located in the beautiful Ozark Mountains in Harrison, Arkansas, the Center will include a great hall, 14 dorm rooms, classrooms and library, a workout facility, basketball court, and a commercial kitchen.







PADERSHIP CENTER

The center will house 24 students and two resident advisers during each nine-month session and consist of the following:

- Provide young Native leaders with intensive discipleship
- Equip them with practical life skills
- Provide an environment and ministry that will bring true healing from the hurt of the past
- Equip for effective Native ministry
- Assist in placement for a lifetime in ministry

The building's dedication will take place this next school year, so watch for more details at summer's end on that celebration!



The favorite area of the Center so far? That'd have to be "Susie Q's Café"—a 50s-themed diner-style eating area named in honor of Ron's late wife, Karen Sousette Hutchcraft, whose first job was at a Dairy Queen. Involved in both the launch and development of RHM and OEW ministries, Karen was active in both ministries before the Lord called her into eternity in 2016.

**Did You Know?** Today there are approximately 325 Native land areas in the U.S. administered as federal reservations where about 13% of Native Americans reside.

Native young people face staggering rates of youth suicide and addiction as well as the highest rates of sexual violence and victimization against women. Living on reservations has been characterized by a U. S. Attorney General as having "an atmosphere of hopelessness."

On Eagles' Wings (OEW) seeks to empower young people to share the hope they've found in Jesus with their own people and equipping them to make a difference in their communities through its annual "Warrior Leadership Summit" conference—and now through the Center at RHM headquarters.
