MONDAY 5/15

TUESDAY 5/16

Up until 1913, a woman representing liberty appeared on the fivecent coin, then from 1913 to 1938 the "Buffalo" nickel, was produced, followed by the images we are now familiar with, Thomas Jefferson and his Monticello home.

WEDNESDAY 5/17

It began in 1900 with one book and transformed into a collection of 40 books, theater productions, and multiple films. L. Frank Baum released **The Wizard of Oz** on this day in 1900. The book became a top seller right away, with multiple translations appearing all over the world.

THURSDAY 5/18

On May 18, 1980, Mount St. Helens, a volcano located in the state of Washington, erupted after weeks of increasing volcanic activity. The eruption, which lasted for nine hours, caused the largest landslide in recorded history and sent a plume of ash and gas high into the atmosphere. The mountain, now 7,980 feet, stood 9,680 feet before its eruption."

FRIDAY 5/19

NASCAR Day is an annual event celebrated on the third Friday of May to promote and raise funds for various charitable organizations supported by NASCAR. The first NASCAR Day was held in 2004, and since then, it has raised millions of dollars for charity.
