MONDAY 6/26

Today is **Forgiveness Day**, when we remember Paul's words: "Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you." (Colossians 3:13)

TUESDAY 6/27

B-I-N-G-O!! Bingo originated in 16th century Italy gaining popularity in Europe before it evolved into the modern version we know today. In the early 20th century, Edwin S. Lowe introduced Bingo in the United States after discovering a similar game called "Beano." Happy National Bingo Day!

WEDNESDAY 6/28

On this day in 1953, workers at a Chevrolet factory in Flint, Michigan, built the inaugural Corvette that would later achieve iconic status in America. Just two days after, the first fully manufactured vehicle was proudly driven off the production line, marking the completion of one of the 300 produced that year.

THURSDAY 6/29

Today marks the 15th anniversary of the groundbreaking **release of the first iPhone**, which revolutionized the world of mobile technology. Back then, the original iPhone hit the market at prices ranging from \$499 to \$599, determined by the storage capacity it offered. Notably, the initial version did not include an App Store, a feature that was introduced a year later.

FRIDAY 6/30

Jean François Gravelet also known as **Charles Blondin**, became the first person to walk across Niagara Falls on a tightrope on June 30, 1859. With thousands of spectators watching, he navigated the 1,100-foot rope above the roaring waters, etching his name in history.

DID YOU KNOW?

- American bingo cards have **5×5 squares**. A bingo card in the UK has three rows and nine columns.
- The original Corvette logo featured the classic checkered flag crossed with the American flag. However, when designers learned that using the US flag on a commercial product was illegal, the logo was changed to the traditional bow-tie emblem and a fleur de lis.
- The iPhone didn't have a front-facing camera until the release of the iPhone 4 in 2010 with the then-new FaceTime video calling.
- Niagara Falls State Park stretches over 400 acres, with close to 140 acres of that under water.
- **3,160 tons of water** flows over Niagara Falls every second.
