THE LATEST FROM AMB-OS

It was thrilling to see this summer's attendance at the *Jesus Revolution* (JR) movie. One never knows how a spiritually-rich film will be received by the general public, but someone must be happy. The last number I saw was that JR enjoyed revenues well north of **\$50 million**.

You no doubt know the film was based, in large measure, on Pastor Greg Laurie's experience as he came to Christ in those wild late 60's in Southern California. Christian music proliferated, solid Bible was teaching pervasive. The result spawned a whole new Maranatha-style culture. Greg described those early days of hippies coming to Christ as, "Something big and volatile was about to happen that only God could orchestrate. It was like nitro meeting glycerin, and the combination was explosive."

Explosive it was! The repercussions from that detonation 50 years ago have continued to these more halcyon days. At each step along the way however, Harvest Christian Fellowship has remained faithful to declare the Word of God. Even more so, the focal point of the church has been holding crusades to reach the lost.



Through those many years, **Ambassador** has served Harvest through the distribution of Greg's winsome and practical Bible teaching via Amb-OS. But more than that, we've transmitted the Harvest Crusade to Christian radio stations. Through the years, there have been many venues, but the most recent is at the Honda Center in Anaheim, where the puck is dropped for the Ducks and their foes.

The 2023 Crusade was a two-night event (July 1 & 2) that featured a number of Christian artists like Chris Tomlin, Phil Wickham, Michael W. Smith and others. Amb-OS delivered the live broadcast to several dozen radio stations which carried it live.

The main focus of the crusade is the simple gospel message. And the result was more than 7,000 people dedicating their lives to Christ over the two-day event. Of these, more than 3,700 professions of faith were in the venue, and over 3,000 were online.

But it doesn't stop there. The following weekend (July 8), it was a joy to see mass baptisms, hearkening back to those crazy days of the late 60's down in Pirate's Cove in Newport Beach. Something in the order of **4,500 were baptized that day**. We stopped by to watch families and friends cheer and hug each other with arms raised for the new day this baptism marked. There were also a number of strangers who came by wondering, "What in the world is this all about?!"



What a joy it is to serve Harvest Christian Fellowship, and have a small part in so many lives coming to Christ!

Interestingly, Harvest Fellowship, has a church located—literally—down the street from us here at Ambassador. Through the years, it's been our privilege to serve Harvest/A New Beginning in one way or another for decades.




