



Though youthful, Victor is an experienced communicator on behalf of that message. In addition to the on-air role, Victor also serves in all facets of communication for Life Issues including creation of the weekly e-delivered Life Issues update to stations.

\rightarrow When did your interest—yea, even passion—for the pro-life message get started?

I grew up in a very pro-life family and have been an advocate for life for many years! There is no question that the unborn are innocent humans that deserve to have their human rights protected. We must speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves.

→ Your Instagram account (which indicates almost 50,000 followers) begins with "Christ is King"—what do you mean by that?

Christ is king means exactly that, there is no higher authority than God. Our society has progressively turned farther and farther from God. As a result, our social values, morals, and culture has begun to rot. If we want what is best for our country, we must once again put Christ first and do all things for His glory.

\rightarrow You're a Missouri native—what do you appreciate most about being raised and living in the Bible Belt territory?

Missouri is a great state, and one of the most pro-life in the nation! The Bible belt is one of the last strongholds for sanity in this country and that is much appreciated. People around here still have a shred of morals left.

\rightarrow Who has been a mentor to you as a young person navigating the segue into such impactful endeavors?

\rightarrow Just for fun ... if you could get on a plane tomorrow, where would you go and why?

\rightarrow You've said you're an old soul in a young body 3 ... what do you mean by that?

I often joke that I am an "old soul" in a young body because in most ways I more resemble someone born many generations ago. Though I am young in years I am, old at heart. My hobbies include things like boxing, chess, billiards, fishing, etc and my taste in music is old country music going back as far as Hank Williams, Sr. However, what I truly mean is that I long for a time I never truly experienced. Our country is far from its golden years. Much of the sick perversion that is spreading in our society would have been unthinkable thirty years ago.

\rightarrow What do you hope to contribute in your role with Life Issues Institute and on-air co-host for Straight Talk on Life Issues?

I aim to contribute the younger perspective of the next generation of pro-life advocates. Social media is an extremely powerful tool that I hope to better use to reach people who are impressionable and convince them to protect life.

Extending the Legacy of Christian Broadcasting

As President/CEO of Bott Radio Network (now more than 120 stations), **Rich Bott** has significantly amplified the work his family began in Christian broadcasting more than 60 years ago. Well known for his leadership in NRB circles (including a season serving as Chairman of the Executive Committee), Rich is also engaged in numerous ministry involvements including serving on the boards of Far East Broadcasting Company and the D.L. Moody Center.

Anyone this involved in Christian media is bound to have more than a few books. Thanks to Rich for sharing a glimpse at some of his shelves!

The first one is the most precious to me. It features a photo of my grandfather, Rev. S. H. Patterson preparing to broadcast his program, "The Radio Prayer League" in Denver in 1926. He is the pioneer Christian Broadcaster in our family. We are honored to follow in his footsteps.

Also on that shelf is an early crystal radio receiver of the type my grandfather first heard R. R. Brown preaching the Gospel all the way from Omaha to his home in western Kansas. That's what inspired his move to Denver to harness the power of Radio to reach more people and multiply the impact of his preaching and teaching of the Bible.





The bookcase next to it includes a C.H. Spurgeon bobblehead, Washington praying at Valley Forge, a collection of Bibles and commentaries, and a prayer sculpture gift from my wife, Faye, reminding us of Jeremiah 29:13 "You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart."



The next bookcase has mementos which remind me that Christian broadcasting is worldwide. The Gospel is for everyone. And I have a favorite quote from Leonard Ravenhill, and a red cup from some of our favorite friends inspiring us to "lead."

The final photo shows my bookcase topped by items from friends at Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Thru the Bible, The Museum of the Bible (including an original brick), a little airplane and a fun lunchbox from special friends, and two copies of our friend Barry Meguiar's new book *Ignite Your Life*. Barry sent me an advance copy to read while I recovered from hip surgery in October, and my endorsement is included on page two!

Next to that bookcase you see a Silvertone tube radio from the 1930s topped by a transistor radio from the 1960s. Above the two

radios is a print of a painting from Israel showing Moses receiving the 10 Commandments. Notice the opened gift box at his feet, as it is a gift to us from God. Also Moses holds up the tablets in the shape of a heart because God gave us the 10 Commandments because He loves us and wants what is best for us. When I see this, it makes me smile.
