Mercy Ships

provided medical help to 2953 patients (3295 surgeries) and offered 1297 healthcare professional training (94,076 hours total). Nearly 60 dentists were educated in eight African nations. *The need for volunteers is so great ... thank you for sharing that with listeners!*



With a thriving international dimension to the ministry,

Revive Our Hearts distributed 250 programs to Vietnam, translated 100 programs into Ukrainian, and welcomed over eight thousand women (representing 34 countries) to the Hispanic conference, **Mujer Verdadera '23**. Over 80 million (!) broadcast/podcast episodes were downloaded in English and Spanish.



From **Focus on the Family**, as they tabulate impact—158,000 people made a decision for Christ, 440,000 couples have built a stronger marriage with 530,000 moms and dads building stronger families. Remarkably, 840,000 people stood up for the helpless, including preborn babies as 5.6 million listeners tuned in weekly to hear the Focus on the Family daily broadcast.



At **Joni and Friends**, the ministry distributed 12,042 wheelchairs with Bibles in 24 countries, served 2453 families in both domestic and international Retreats and Getaways, with 6610 volunteers serving. Read more about this on page 5!

THE LATEST FROM AMB-OS

"There is nothing permanent except change." — Heraclitus

No one would argue with Heraclitus, nor with the fact that the *pace of change* is increasing as well.

While it's entertaining to consider, focusing on change is a "rearview mirror" perspective. It really doesn't do well to inform us on what the future holds. Sound business decisions require some "windshield" intelligence as to where the changes will lead us in the days ahead.

"The Great One" used to say his success in hockey was, in large measure, knowing *where to skate*: To anticipate where the puck will be, not where it's been. And that's a great metaphor for those of us in an industry driven by hardware and software technology replete with change. We need to intuit where the technological puck is going.

While there's no one simple answer to the question, the Bible does help us here. Proverbs affirms there is "wisdom in the counsel of many." (Proverbs 15:22) It's helpful to have like-minded observers congregate to think on the future. The wisdom of the many will help us know where to skate.

Therein lies the value of joining the National Religious Broadcasters. We gather to consider and confer on the future of our industry. And this year, we have no shortage on questions to consider. Here are a few:

- What is the future of radio (AM in particular)? What will congress do and what impact will that have on automakers of EV and combustion vehicles?
- What are the best podcasting practices? Is it possible to sustain itself based on subscription or advertising?
- Where do ministries find new supporters?
- How should ministries best allocate their media budget?
- What role will AI have in the future of content?

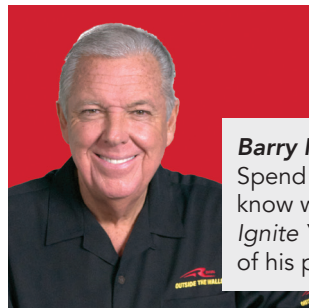
Adam Holz (Plugged In)

Popular speaker and author, Lisa is director of young adults for Focus on the Family and heard regularly on The Boundless Show.



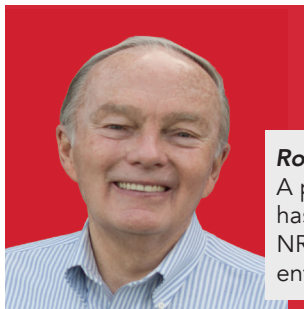
Mark Gauthier (Making Your Life Count)

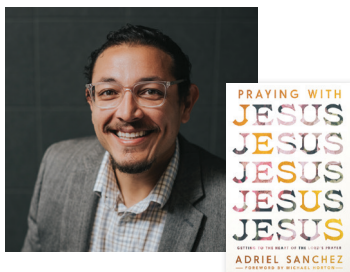

Praying with Jesus: Getting to the Heart of the Lord's Prayer

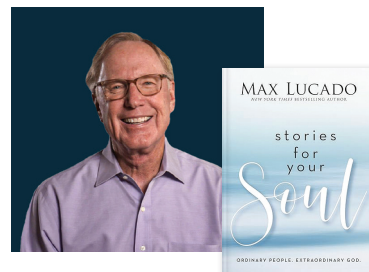
From Adriel Sanchez

“ This is my office bookshelf. If you ever do a Zoom meeting with me, this is what you'll see behind me. (Charles Morris always told me books are some of the best sound baffling, and he was right.)

Yes, there are Bibles, various commentaries, and theological reference books, but there are four items I'll call out as especially important to me.

My late grandfather's Bible (laying flat on the top of the stack next to the microphone) is a treasure to me. He poured his passion for Christ and the Word of God into my life. Every time I pick it up, I recall the countless conversations we had about life, Scripture, and following Jesus. It's a 1945 KJV, Oxford binding. The pages are so worn many are held together by scotch tape and there is not a page in it without notes and scribbles from his many years of study. I pray I may pass a similar legacy to my own family when Christ calls me home someday.



The funny looking hat on the top right is an **Ak-kalpak**, the traditional hat worn by men in Kyrgyzstan. It was a gift from my Kyrgyz colleagues at FEBC when I was there a few years ago. These white felt hats are worn everywhere you go. I remember attending the ordination service of a Kyrgyz pastor and every man present was wearing one. It's a reminder to me that God is working, even in countries like Kyrgyzstan where fewer than 1% of the population are Christians.

The glass ship on the top was a gift from the staff at Haven Ministries when God called me away for a season working in consulting and world missions.

The dates inscribed on it are "2005 to 2016." I'm so thrilled to get an opportunity to serve the Lord Jesus with Charles and my friends at Haven once again.

On the lower right you'll see a **complete expository commentary set by Charles Simeon**. This late preacher is one of my heroes—and through his writings, a frequent conversation partner when I get ready to preach. He pastored a church in Cambridge, England, for 49 years and was a champion for Gospel-centered preaching. His love for Christ in his preaching fueled revival among students and has influenced many since, including John Stott (another hero). ”
