Solar Eclipse: Twice Each Year?

You've probably seen a few eclipse stories from April 8, 2024. To be in the right spot at the right time with the right weather . . . that's a real treat. We won't experience another total eclipse in the US until August 23, 2044. And I'd like to see that. For quite a few reasons!

While a solar eclipse is rare, in the satellite world, it happens twice every year: Spring and Fall. The phenomenon is called a "Solar Transit Outage." It occurs when the sun, the satellite in question (ours is SES-2 at 87°W) and a station's receiver antenna are in

alignment. When that happens, the sun's energy overpowers the satellite's signal. The result is nothing but noise for 5 to 10 minutes each day, at approximately the same time, over a five to eight day period.

This is a real problem for live satellite broadcasters! Our solution comes from the fact that the solar outages are predictable down to the minute. So, historically, we pre-record programs and feed them to stations ahead of time. That's been our only way to work around the problem . . . until now!

We've been in development of our enhanced terrestrial transmission service, "SvI" (Satellite via Internet). It adds "fail-over" capability to the AMR-100 and AMR-200 receivers. The technology allows us to eliminate live audio outages by moving satellite receivers automatically to SvI. In fact, we did precisely this during the most recent spring sun transit period. Neither live nor pre-recorded program delivery is affected. And the best news is that our latency is almost non-existent when switching between SvI and satellite. 
