Vonette Bright entered into the presence of the Lord she so faithfully served all her life on December 23, 2015.

The tributes since her passing are appropriately multitudinous—and all reflect the impact of her life on so many spheres of influence. Her ebullient outlook on life perpetually brought joy to those who were privileged to know her. At the same time, her passion for Christ could often evoke conviction as she was a powerful promoter of prayer (founder of the National Day of Prayer, in fact) and a consistent voice for evangelism—a calling she shared with her husband, Bill Bright, as co-founders of Campus Crusade for Christ (Cru).

For nearly two decades, Vonette became a regular part of the Christian broadcasting community with "Women Today"—a daily 1:00 feature heard on hundreds of stations across the country and around the globe. That outreach amplified the many other avenues Vonette was afforded as a Christian leader to convey her life's core message ... that this was the God who could indeed be trusted.

For the Ambassador team, it was a deep joy to support Vonette's work in serving "Women Today." Like so many others, we will miss that gracious "honey" salutation that was so authentically Vonette.

We will miss the confidence that was unfailingly hers in leaning into God's ordination—even when it meant releasing her beloved Bill into eternity years before He called her home too. We will miss her relentless voice of spiritual wisdom and the call to prayer that became the hallmark of her ministry.

But we rejoice in the reward of this servant who has, indeed, done well. With gratitude for the inspiration of her life example that will continue to encourage generations into the future.





legacy of Chuck Colson can equip Christians to live a bold and loving faith in the public square.


