Changes Yet Again!



ay I confess the speed of technological change these days makes my head swim? Al is at the center of the cause. I'm amazed, time after time, at the power of AI and applications everywhere.

I had to laugh when I used AI to see what it would write for me as I prepared my father-of-the-bride speech for my daughter's wedding. It made me cry! That may say more about how I feel about my daughter than the technology, but I assure you, our lives are on the cusp of dramatic change in ways we can't imagine today. The changes are filled with both blessings and curses.

That's true as we face modifications at Amb-OS too. Last month in this column, we reviewed our move from satellite as the primary delivery technology to something called "SvI," or "Satellite via Internet." (You can read last month's Update column to learn more.) Moving off satellite will keep program delivery unfettered even though our satellite, SES-2, is going dark. Best news is that there's nothing any station needs to do to make the change with us.

There's one other Amb-OS feature also being retired. It's the "XDS Transfers" feature in our User Interface (UI). This setting is located on the UI "System Information" page. The feature will come to an end as Moody Radio is terminating file delivery on their XDS receivers. (Moody will continue to operate their FTP site for program delivery.)

It's been a joy to partner with MBN these many years with their XDS file delivery project. Both Amb-OS and Moody Radio have been members of the CRC since 2000. The outcome has been an exemplary working relationship that's helped stations around the country.







Whose own life was transformed by the sharing of testimony, **John Sorensen** (President of Evangelism Explosion) is thoroughly unabashed about the power of telling others about Jesus. Hear his encouragement daily on "Share Life Today."

Have you ever questioned the significance of your testimony or thought that no one was interested in hearing it? Allow me to share a profound truth from Scripture: "And they overcame [the enemy] by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony" (Revelation 12:11). Your testimony is not just a story, but a powerful tool in the hands of God.

KNOW THE POWER OF YOUR STORY

Testimonies matter. God has given each of us a powerful story to share. And it's the first act of sharing the Gospel with others. When Jesus healed the man filled with demons in the Gadarenes, He said, "Go home to your friends and tell them what great things the Lord has done for you and how he has had compassion on you." We are called to do the same! One of the most effective tools we have to start spiritual conversations with others is our testimonies, sharing how Jesus has changed our lives. When we know how powerful sharing our story is, it gives us confidence to bring it up in conversations and share it!

MAKE THE CONNECTION

How do we do that? Well, think about what you like to talk about with your friends. You want to hear about their life! And this is also true for your coworkers, friends, and family—they want to know about you, too. You might be surprised at how many of them would love to hear your story about how Jesus has changed your life. This is why our testimonies are so powerful! God has crafted the human heart to connect with

others through sharing experiences. Jesus connected with people the same way—through hearing their stories and sharing with them about Who He is—the Savior who has come to redeem them.

BE GENUINE

More than ever, people are looking for genuine, authentic relationships. They want to hear the truth. And when it comes to sharing our testimonies, it's important to be genuine and vulnerable while telling others our story. God may have you sharing with a "Divine Appointment"—a person He has drawn to you to hear your story for a purpose. It could be that the same struggles or hurt you have faced they are facing now. It could be the very things God has redeemed in your life they are dealing with, too. Make sure to ask the Holy Spirit to guide your conversation and what you should share, and be open and truthful with what God has done in your life.

MAKE THE CONTRAST

Start with what life was like before everything changed or before God stepped in. Then, share what God did. End your testimony with something about the confidence you have

concerning Heaven and eternal life. An example would be something like, "The greatest thing about all of this is that I know for sure that if I died today, I'm going to Heaven." This leads very naturally to asking them questions about their own spiritual life and sharing the Gospel with them.

The truth is God has blessed you, changed you, and transformed you. Tell the world how! Take the bold step. Share your story! And may God bless you as you do so!
