Wollen's Pizza Dough





About the Recipe

David has had a 16-year obsession with making pizza from scratch. It starts with the dough. And by its looks, it is better than a restaurant could make. Marci shared this story of the recipe's beginnings:

A few years into our marriage we took a five-day backpacking trip down the Grand Canyon followed by a few days at home for a staycation. I asked David how he would like to spend some of that time, and he said he wanted to perfect pizza. That started a journey of tweaking the recipe for pizza dough and getting creative with toppings.

Now, we love growing our own tomatoes in our garden and making our own pizza sauce. We like to harvest enough tomatoes in the fall to make enough sauce to last us through the winter. Some of David's favorite toppings are pepperoni, fresh tomato, a little onion, and green pepper. Our oldest daughter added chopped bacon and that's become an absolute must in our family.

Ingredients

For 2 pizzas:

- 1 package (7 g) instant yeast
- 1 ⅓ c water (255 g, warm)
- 1 Tbsp honey
- 2 Tbsp Extra Virgin Olive Oil
- 2 ½ c (410 g) bread flour
- ½ tsp salt

Directions

- 1. Combine yeast and warm water. Add oil and honey.
- 2. Add flour and salt. Mix in a stand mixer with a dough hook at lowest speed for 3 minutes.
- 3. Mix on medium speed for 1 minute.
- **4.** Cover bowl with plastic wrap and let sit for 20 minutes.
- **5.** Mix on low speed for 3 minutes and transfer dough to a large bowl; cover and let rise 2-4 hours.
- **6.** An hour before making pizza, divide into two balls, place on two separate sheets of parchment paper. Cover with a large mixing bowl to prevent it from drying out.
- 7. 20 minutes prior to baking, preheat pizza stone in oven to 500°.
- 8. Roll out the dough, add sauce and your favorite toppings.
- **9.** Bake for 10-12 minutes. If using thicker crust, allow the pizza to stand 3 more minutes on the pizza stone after removing from the oven.
