

in real time—an airplane's flight path, altitude, ground speed, tail number and enough minutiae to kill a cat. One friend who shares my passion for aviation has the same software running 24x7 on an iPad in his office. There's something alluring about watching a very complex matrix of aircraft moving this way and that across the surface of the planet.

Candidly, my Flight Radar addiction is exacerbated by the fact that the approach to SNA here in Orange County is right outside my office window. The glide path is so close I can wave at passengers without leaving my desk. When they pass my window, planes are descending at 500 feet AGL and traveling about 140 knots. That's slow enough to see terrified passengers pressing their noses to the window. One time, I stood in our parking lot waving a huge American flag to make it easier to spot the office for a particular passenger!

Similarly, when **I'm** on one of those planes coming into John Wayne, I look for our office building by scanning for the most prominent building feature—the 10-foot satellite antenna on our warehouse roof.

However, as these photos confirm, that day has sadly come to an end. Our big C-Band satellite dish is gone! Taking the dish down confirms that Amb-OS has fully migrated to "IP delivery" of live and pre-recorded programs. This change was a consequence of our space segment provider not replacing the end-of-life bird we were using (SES2).

Subsequent to fully transitioning off satellite, our team set out to disassemble our primary satellite antenna on the roof. Sadly, our effort to remove and recycle hundreds of pounds of antenna steel and ballast yielded merely \$12.00 in recycling. Hardly seemed a worthwhile venture!

So ... it's a new day for Amb-OS. And while it may be harder to spot AAA when you're heading into John Wayne, just let me know ... I'll gladly greet you by heartily waving our U.S. Flag!





We're pleased to let station partners know about these two new impactful resources. While very different presentations, each film is designed to encourage believers in their faith—and how to put it into action.


JUST RELEASED


From Hutchcraft Ministries
